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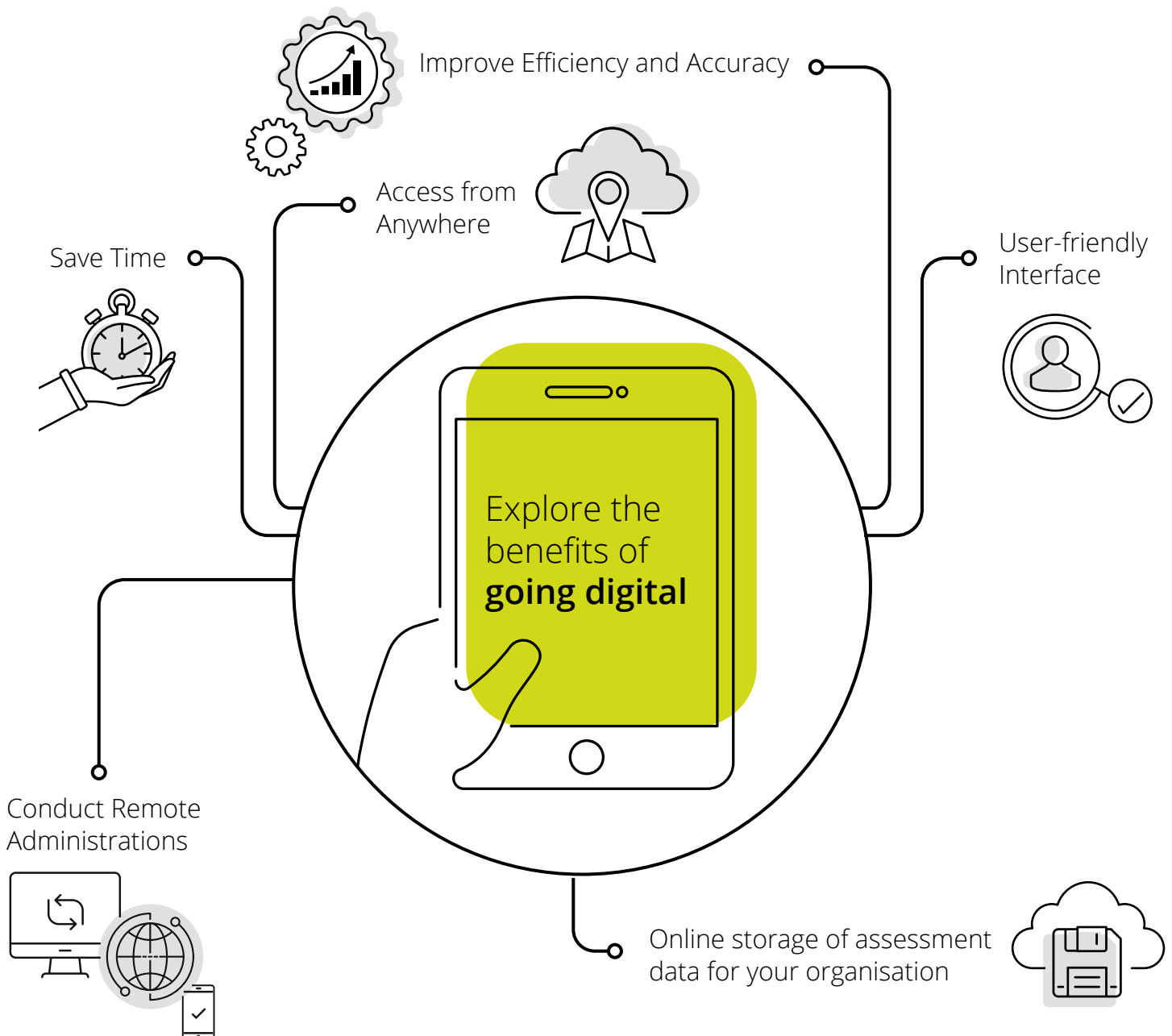

Q-global™ is our secure and affordable web-based administration, scoring and reporting system that allows you to input results from paper-and-pencil assessments to generate scores, and produce accurate comprehensive reports.

It can also be used to administer questionnaire type assessments either on your screen or via a secure link emailed to the examinee or caregiver.

Certain assessment resources are now also available to use in a 'Telepractice' setting. Q-global® houses the industry's gold standard assessment tools that Speech Language Therapists, Occupational Therapists, SENCOS, and Psychologists can access through any device connected to an up-to-date web browser.

## How does it work?

Q-global allows you to manage and retrieve examinee information, generate scores from assessment data, and produce accurate, comprehensive assessment reports. All these activities are performed in a secure, private web environment that helps professionals streamline their assessment workflow while complying with widely accepted data privacy standards. The web-based nature of Q-global provides you with unprecedented flexibility in accessing your assessment records and reports anytime and anywhere.

Flexible delivery and reporting

Q-global® offers four different delivery and reporting options, to best suit your methods of assessment:

- 1. On Screen administration (OSA)** - Conduct assessments on screen using your own device or set up a video proctoring session 'in platform' using [Q-global VP](#).
- 2. Remote On-Screen administration (ROSA)** - Send assessment via email to examinee, parent or caregiver to complete.
- 3. Manual Entry** - Enter assessment data from a paper record form.
- 4. Via Telepractice** - Deliver certain assessments via remote screensharing technology before entering data into the platform to score.

Once assessment data is received into the platform via any of the above methods, you can seamlessly generate a report. Options for delivery vary by assessment, see our availability matrix on page 5 for options.





## Who can use Q-global?

## Introducing Q-interactive

Q-interactive is an easy-to-use iPad application that allows clinicians to choose, administer and score assessments via two tablets that connect to each other. The system is ideal for educational and clinical psychologists, SLTs, and SENCO's.

With Q-interactive, you can create personalized batteries at both the instrument and subtest levels that are proven to:

- Better serve your clients and evolve your practice.
- Minimize time spent on administering tests.
- Streamline workflow and reduce manual data entry.

## How does it work?

1. Assessment administration occurs using two iPads that talk to each other via Bluetooth connection. With just a tap of a finger, you can easily customize a battery based on client's needs. Administer the full test, or only the subtests that you need.
2. You use one tablet to read administration instructions, record, and score responses, take notes, and control visual stimuli. The client uses the other to view and respond to stimuli.
3. Real time scoring means once you have completed the assessment battery, you can instantly view subtest scores and notes. Encrypted data is stored on your iPad and then synchronized over a secure connection to our server where it is stored in an encrypted database with industry-standard technology.

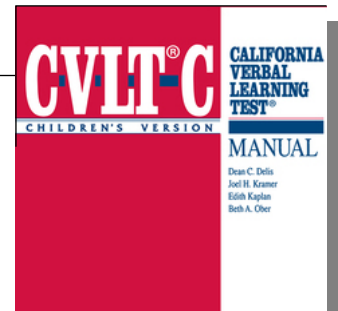

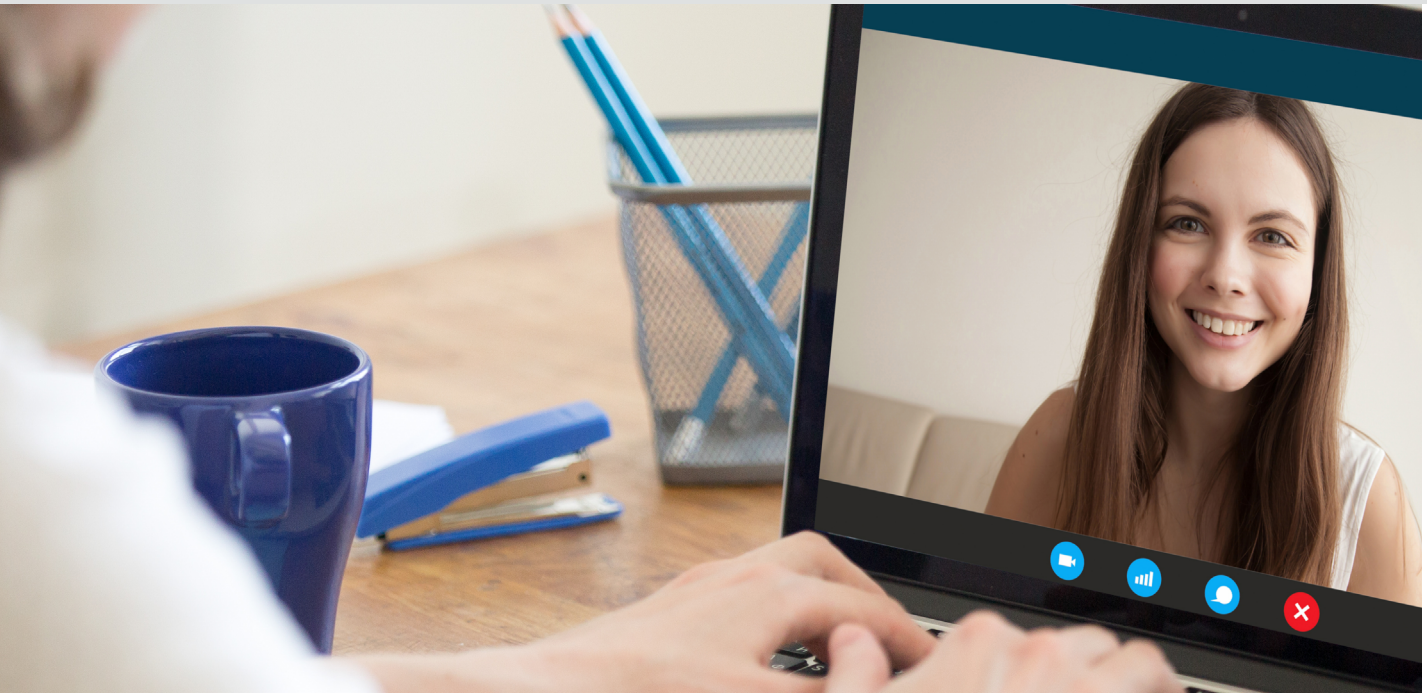
