# The Dyslexia Index


- Individual administration time of 20 minutes or less

- Screening for children and adults, covering the full age range of the KTEA-3 and WIAT-4
- · Clinical results for differentiating dyslexia groups from matched control groups were significant (p<.01) with very large effect sizes (1.76-2.11)
- Option to contribute the results to a comprehensive evaluation without readministering subtests




# **Composite Structure**
